The gallery at the Kimmel Harding Nelson Center for the Arts plans to mount five or more exhibitions showcasing the work of Nebraska artists annually. Artists will be selected through a juried application process and/or by invitation.

Applicants may propose solo or group exhibitions.

Exhibiting artists must assume responsibility and cost for transporting work to and from the Center and must be available for an artist's reception during the exhibition. The artist also must assume all costs for preparing (matting, framing, etc.) his or her work for exhibition. Works should be available for sale. The Art Center does not take a sales commission.

Exhibitions will run for approximately eight weeks, with the beginning and ending dates determined by the needs of the Art Center.

The Center will publicize the exhibition and reception. A limited number of postcards will be provided to the artist for distribution by the artist at his or her mailing cost.

The Art Center assumes no liability for damage and no insurance.

Please refer to the attached diagram of the gallery for usable wall space and room dimensions before proposing an exhibition.

Applications for will be accepted until October 1 for the following year.

To apply, please send the following either by mail, hand-delivery, or by e-mail attachment:

1. A one-page résumé or narrative biographical information with current address, phone number, e-mail address. *Please do not send press clippings, brochures, or other supplemental material.*
2. An artist's statement and description of the work to be exhibited. Include a good estimate of the number of pieces, dimensions, and media of work to be exhibited.
3. Five to ten jpegs of work representative of the work to be exhibited. *(No Photoshop files.)* Jpegs should be no larger than 700 ppi on the longest dimension. *If you would like to submit in a different format, please call or e-mail the executive director at the Center.* CDs will be returned if an SASE is enclosed with the application.
4. Proposed dates when your work would be available for exhibition.

Applications will be judged on the quality of the work submitted.
